The tree planting day on November 26th was very successful – and the weather was 2015!






Detail (1) Income £33,531

5. Amendment of Articles

Our bank, the Co-operative bank, has pointed out an inconsistency in the Financial Arrangements section following our incorporation.

Proposal 1

Existing wording:

38.(2) The authorised signatories shall be the treasurer, secretary and two other directors. All cheques payable on the account shall be signed by two signatories.

New wording:

38.(2) The authorised signatories shall be directors. All cheques payable on the account shall be signed by two signatories.

NB: Current signatories are Mike Cosby, Geoff Craddock, Roger Durman and Richard Yonge

There are further issues which can be addressed at the same time by the following proposals.

Proposal 2.

Existing wording:

17. (1) at each annual general meeting all directors shall retire but will be eligible for nomination for reelection.

New wording:

17. (1) at each annual general meeting all directors except the representative of the landowner shall retire but will be eligible for nomination for re-election.

Proposal 3.

Existing wording:

- 3 (2) The board of directors shall include the following:
 - a. chairman as directed by the Companies Act 2006
 - b. treasurer
 - c. secretary
 - d. representative of the landowner
 - e. a minimum of two other persons as representatives of the members and/or the community of Yealmpton

New wording:

- 3 (2) The board of directors shall include the following:
 - a. chairman as directed by the Companies Act 2006
 - b. representative of the landowner
 - c. a minimum of two other persons as representatives of the members and/or the community of Yealmpton

It was resolved, by unanimous votes, that the new wording proposed in all three proposals be adopted.



6. Prohibited items

It is proposed that we be more diligent in implementing the rules about what can and cannot be left on the site.

This sign will advise members that offending items will be removed!

Our Membership Rules require that:

- Only trees from our approved list and supplied by the Association may be planted.
- Only wildflowers from our approved list may be planted.
- Cut flowers (but not artificial flowers) are permitted provided they are not in plastic wrappings or other non-bio-degradable material. A pottery (but not glass) vase may be set into the ground above graves.
- Floral tributes constructed on plastic frames may be placed on a grave on the day of a burial but must be removed within 14 days.
- No artefacts except an approved slate plaque may be left anywhere on the site.
 Artefacts include ornaments, vases and ribbons. Nothing must be tied to trees.

Offending items may be removed without notice. At our discretion, they may be left in the Field Shelter but will be disposed of after 14 days if not collected.
