1 Introduction and Statutory Information

- 1.1 I, Gordon Johnston of Fortus Recovery Limited, was appointed as Joint Liquidator of Vogue Corporation Limited (the **Company**) on 17 February 2021 together with my colleague Shane Biddlecombe. This report provides an update on the progress in the liquidation for year ended 16 February 2022. (the **Period**).
- 1.2 Fortus Recovery's Privacy Notice about the way that we will use and store personal data can be found at www.fortusrecovery.co.uk/privacy-policy. If you are unable to access this, please contact our office and a hard copy will be provided to you.
- 1.3 The trading address of the Company was 24 Edison Road, St Ives, Cambridgeshire, PE27 3LF.
- 1.4 The registered office of the Company has been changed to Fortus Recovery Ltd, Grove House, Meridians Cross, Ocean Village, Southampton, SO14 3TJ and its registered number is 09186289.

2 Progress of the Liquidation

- 2.1 At Appendix A, I have provided an account of my Receipts and Payments for the Period, with a comparison to the Declaration of Solvency values.
- 2.2 I am pleased to report that the following assets have been realised in the liquidation.

Business Rates Refund

2.3 The sum of £1,087.55 has been received from Huntingdonshire District Council in respect of a business rates refund due to the Company.

Credit Balance - HSBC card Facility

2.4 Following appointment, we were advised that there was a credit of £579.28 on a card facility in the Company's name which has been received in full.

PAYE Refund

2.5 The director has advised that the Company is due a refund of £535.97 from HM Revenue & Customs in respect of tax overpaid which has yet to be received.

Third Party Funds Received in Error

2.6 The Company settled its final corporation tax liability prior to liquidation on 16 February 2020. However, as the incorrect reference was applied, HM Revenue & Customs issued a refund to the Company of £19,442.13 which has been returned accordingly.

Outstanding Matters

- 2.7 The Liquidators are required to submit a corporation tax return to HM Revenue & Customs on the anniversary of their appointment. In this case, there will be a tax liability to settle in respect of the business rates refund received which is estimated to be £206.53 and will be settled in due course.
- 2.8 Following the period covered by this report we have been made aware that the Company was party to a lease in respect of the trading premises. An assignment of the lease was agreed prior to the Liquidators' appointment but was not completed. Now that the Company is in liquidation the Liquidators will need to be party to the assignment and they are currently liquising with their solicitors in respect of this matter and the likely costs involved.

3 Distributions to Members

- 3.1 The following cash distribution to the member has been made since the date of my appointment:
 - An initial distribution of £440.51 per share on 1 April 2021. The total amount distributed was £881.02.

4 Liquidators' Remuneration

- 4.1 The Liquidators fees and disbursements were agreed and paid to Fortus Recovery Limited prior to the commencement of the liquidation and amounted to £2,000 plus VAT and £405.50 plus VAT respectively.
- 4.2 Attached as Appendix B is additional information in relation to the Liquidators' fees.
- 4.3 A copy of 'A Shareholders' Guide to Liquidators' Fees' is available on request or can be downloaded from http://www.fortusrecovery.co.uk/publications/.

5 Members' Rights

- 5.1 Within 21 days of the receipt of this report, members with either at least 5% of the total voting rights of all the members having the right to vote at general meetings of the Company or with the permission of the court, may request in writing that the Liquidators provide further information about their remuneration or expenses which have been itemised in this progress report.
- 5.2 Any members with at least 10% of the total voting rights of all the members having the right to vote at general meetings of the Company may within 8 weeks of receipt of this progress report, make an application to court on the grounds that, in all the circumstances, the basis fixed for the Liquidators' remuneration is inappropriate and/or the remuneration charged or the expenses incurred by the Liquidators, as set out in this progress report, are excessive.

6 Next Report

6.1 I am required to provide a further report on the progress of the liquidation within two months of the end of the second anniversary of the liquidation, unless I have concluded matters prior to this, in which case I will write again with my proposed final account.

Additional Information in Relation to Liquidators' Fees

1 Staff allocation and the use of subcontractors

- 1.1 The general approach to resourcing our assignments is to allocate staff with the skills and experience to meet the specific requirements of the case.
- 1.2 The constitution of the case team will usually consist of a Partner, a Manager, and an Administrator or Assistant. The exact constitution of the case team will depend on the anticipated size and complexity of the assignment and the experience requirements of the assignment.
- 1.3 We are not proposing to utilise the services of any sub-contractors in this case.

2 Professional Advisers

2.1 We have not used the services of any professional advisers in respect of this assignment.

3 Liquidators' Disbursements

- 3.2 Category 2 disbursements do require approval from members.
