INTRODUCTION

Saga Healthcare Limited (Entity) entered members’ voluntary liquidation on 27 January 2022. Laura Waters and Steven Sherry were appointed joint liquidators of the Entity (Liquidators).

This report covers the conduct and progress of the liquidation in the period from 27 January 2022 to 26 January 2023 (Period).

A summary of receipts and payments for this Period is at Appendix A.

The statutory information relating to the Entity and the Liquidators is at Appendix B.

REPORT ON THE LIQUIDATION

Realisation of assets:

There were no assets identified within the Directors’ Declaration of Solvency.

The Liquidators have not identified any assets of the Entity in the Period and are not aware of any other assets that remain to be realised.

Settlement of liabilities:

In the Period, the Liquidators published a notice in the London Gazette inviting creditors to submit details of claims they may have against the Entity.

The Directors’ Declaration of Solvency showed that the Entity had no liabilities.

In the Period, the Liquidators received a claim against the Entity from NHS Dorset for the sum of £701.20. The claim was agreed by the Liquidators and settled on a non recourse basis by the Entity’s shareholder, Saga Group Limited, together with statutory interest. No other claims have been received.

HM Revenue & Customs (“HMRC”):

In the Period, the Liquidators wrote to HMRC to inform them of the liquidation and to request details of any outstanding liabilities.

On 1 November 2022, HMRC issued a £200 late filing penalty in relation to the Entity’s FY21 tax return. Saga Group Limited arranged payment in settlement of the penalty together with accrued interest shortly thereafter, but HMRC has not yet allocated payment to the Entity’s account. As such, HMRC has not confirmed tax clearance to close the liquidation. The Liquidators have been liaising with HMRC with a view to resolving the allocation and obtaining clearance as soon as possible.

Distributions to Members:

No distributions were made during the Period.

A distribution will not be made during the course of the liquidation as the entity does not hold any assets.

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LIQUIDATORS' FEES AND EXPENSES

Basis of remuneration

The basis of the Liquidators' remuneration has been fixed by reference to the time properly given by them and their staff in dealing with the liquidation, in accordance with a resolution dated 27 January 2022.

Liquidators' remuneration

Fees and expenses of the liquidation have been paid to PricewaterhouseCoopers LLP by another group company under a separate contractual arrangement. There is no recourse to the liquidation estate.

The Liquidators have separately provided the sole Member with the information required in accordance with Statement of Insolvency Practice 7.

Members' rights regarding the Liquidators' remuneration and expenses

Any member of the Entity with permission of the court or members of the Entity with at least 5% of the total voting rights of all the members having the right to vote at general meetings of the entity (or permission of the court) are entitled to request further information about our fees and expenses. Such requests need to be made within 21 days of receipt of this report. See Rule 18.9 of the Insolvency (England and Wales) Rules 2016 for further detail.

Any member of the Entity with permission of the court or members of the Entity with at least 10% of the total voting rights of all the members having the right to vote at general meetings of the entity (or permission of the court) are entitled to claim by way of court application that the liquidators' fees and expenses are excessive. Such applications need to be made within 8 weeks of the receipt of this report. See Rule 18.34 of the Insolvency (England and Wales) Rules 2016 for further detail.
