

Any dividends will be distributed among the holders of the Series A1 Preferred Shares and Series A2 Preferred Shares, prior and in preference to Ordinary Shares, until such time as each Series A1 Preferred Shareholder and Series A2 Preferred Shareholder has received in aggregate an amount per Series A1 Preferred Share and Series A2 Preferred Share equal to the Preferred Subscription Price. After payment of such dividends, any further dividends or distributions of Available Profits shall be distributed among all holders of Series A1 Preferred Shares, Series A2 Preferred Shares and Ordinary Shares in proportion to the number of Ordinary Shares that would be held by each such holder if all Series A1 Preferred Shares and Series A2 Preferred Shares were converted to Ordinary Shares at the then effective conversion rate.

- (b) after the payment in full of all payments required to be paid to the Series A1 Preferred Shareholders and Series A2 Preferred Shareholders also, the remaining assets of the Company available for such distribution shall be distributed among the Series A1 Preferred Shareholders, Series A2 Preferred Shareholders and Ordinary Shareholders pro rate based on the number of shares held by each such holder, treating for this purpose all such securities as if they had been converted to Ordinary Shares.
