NOTES TO THE ABRIDGED FINANCIAL STATEMENTS

for the financial year ended 31 January 2021

1. General Information

CDC Aerotech Services Limited is a company limited by shares incorporated in the United Kingdom. The registered office of the company is 9 Highland Road, Weymouth, Dorset, DT4 0BG, United Kingdom which is also the principal place of business of the company. The principal activity of the company is the provision of consultancy in fishing, marine and aircraft engineering. The financial statements have been presented in Pound Sterling (£) which is also the functional currency of the company.

2. Summary of Significant Accounting Policies

The following accounting policies have been applied consistently in dealing with items which are considered material in relation to the company's financial statements.

Statement of compliance

The financial statements of the company for the year ended 31 January 2021 have been prepared in accordance with the provisions of FRS 102 Section 1A (Small Entities) and the Companies Act 2006.

Basis of preparation

The financial statements have been prepared on the going concern basis and in accordance with the historical cost convention except for certain properties and financial instruments that are measured at revalued amounts or fair values, as explained in the accounting policies below. Historical cost is generally based on the fair value of the consideration given in exchange for assets.

Turnover

Turnover comprises the invoice value of goods supplied by the company, exclusive of trade discounts and value added tax.

Tangible fixed assets and depreciation

Tangible fixed assets are stated at cost or at valuation, less accumulated depreciation. The charge to depreciation is calculated to write off the original cost or valuation of tangible fixed assets, less their estimated residual value, over their expected useful lives as follows:

Plant and machinery	- 15% Reducing balance
Fixtures, fittings and equipment	- 15% Straight line

The carrying values of tangible fixed assets are reviewed annually for impairment in periods if events or changes in circumstances indicate the carrying value may not be recoverable.

Trade and other creditors

Trade and other creditors are initially recognised at fair value and thereafter stated at amortised cost using the effective interest rate method, unless the effect of discounting would be immaterial, in which case they are stated at cost.

Taxation

Current tax represents the amount expected to be paid or recovered in respect of taxable profits for the financial year and is calculated using the tax rates and laws that have been enacted or substantially enacted at the Balance Sheet date.

Ordinary share capital

The ordinary share capital of the company is presented as equity.

3. Going concern

These accounts have been prepared on the going concern basis, on the understanding that there was a net deficiency of assets of £313 at the balance sheet date, however the directors have confirmed continued support and consider the company retains sufficient working capital to continue trading for the foreseeable future.

4. Employees
