  may in its absolute discretion consider appropriate in connection with the exercise of any powers in the
  Lender and any person appointed the substitute or delegate of the Lender shall in exercising the said
  power of attorney be the Agent of the Debtor who alone shall be responsible for the acts and defaults of
  such substituted person or delegate and the Lender shall not be responsible for any misconduct
  negligence or default of such substituted person or delegate.

  MATRIMONAL HOMES (FAMILY PROTECTION) (SCOTLAND) ACT 1981 AS AMENDED
  Where the Debtor in the Standard Security where appropriate has not signed an Affidavit, that the Property
  Is not a matrimonial home in terms of the Matrimonial Homes (Family Protection) (Scotland) Act 1981 as
  amended or where the Lender has dispensed with the requirement for the Debtor is the same.
