2	Unless the context requires otherwise, other words or expressions contained in these Articles bear the same meaning as in the Companies Act 2006 as in force on the date when these Articles become binding on the Co-operative Schedule 1 of the Companies (Model Articles) Regulations 2008 shall apply to the Co-operative, save where amended or replaced by these Articles In the case of any variation or inconsistency between these Articles and the model articles, these Articles shall prevail
5	The purpose of the Company is to carry out its function as a co-operative and to abide by the internationally recognised co-operative values and Co-operative Principles as defined by the International Co-operative Alliance. This article is Entrenched in accordance with section 22 of the Act, any alteration to this article requires the approval of 100% of the Members.
13	Membership is voluntary and open to all persons able to use the services of the Company and willing to accept the responsibilities of membership, without gender, social, racial, political or religious discrimination.
20	In accordance with the Co-operative Principle of education, training and information, the Company shall provide potential Members with information about what the role of a Member is within the Company and will provide training in the skills required to be a Member and to participate in the operation of the Co-operative
21	The Company shall provide ongoing education and training in co-operative values and Co-operative Principles and associated topics. The Company shall support its Members by ensuring that general meetings are accessible and encourage participation.

(4) All references to "the Company" in clauses 2 to 96 shall be changed to "the Co-operative" in accordance with clause 1.
