Newcastle Cricket Club CIC was created in response to Government changes in requirements for Community Amateur Sports Clubs. Two special member meetings authorised the creation of the community interest company in March 2015; it was also agreed to delay the start of trading until the start of October 2015 so that it would match the accounting period for the financial year.

So from October 2015, the club's activities included competitive cricket with teams drawn from the Senior Cricket, Girls & Women and Junior squads; participation and development work including coaching, festivals, summer camps and outreach in schools; community activities including social events, musical performances, meeting and function provision and the provision of a Bar.

From October 2016, the club added winter cricket training, an annual Festival, hosting two other sports clubs (for hockey and lacrosse) and a wide range of community meetings to the activities carried out.
