The 49th annual Folk Festival was postponed due to the impact of the Covid-19 pandemic. Support for the festival is still strong from both ticket buyers and general public alike, and the 49th Festival is now planned for Friday 28th – Monday 31st May 2021.

The CIC Directors (and managers of the festival) have agreed that the festival is still working within the aims and objectives of the company.

Financially the Company has received additional grant funding from local authorities and Arts Council England to support the Festival through the pandemic.

The Festival brings significant benefits to the host town which promotes good local participation, support, and wellbeing in the town and surrounding area.
