This year we have developed projects with local (Wirral) based charities and third sector organisation. We have continued to oversee the local council's Family Coaching initiative and have further developed our training portfolio.

We have also continued to develop our Guild model to offer ongoing support for those we train and who are working in the community.

Through the Metanoeo Foundation we have been able to offer a free life coach training place on each course we have run which has increased our provision for the marginalised and disadvantaged enabling members of the public to complete our training for free.

This year our turnover increase to £18,925. This trading increase has come about through the ongoing development of relationships with the local third sector as a result of our involvement in the family coaching initiative in partnership with Wirral council.

Our stakeholders are the community projects we partner with along the individuals who become guild members.

Regular meetings are held with guild members individually to consider how their participation may be grown along with CPD events where members receive training but also share their own stories and network with other members. We are continuing to offer a peer supervision group and now also offer 1-2-1 supervision.

Discussions with partner groups through projects such as *Cultivating Coaching Cultures* and our *Level 5 Accredited Award in Community-Based Life Coaching* continue to guide the services we provide. As a result of these conversations each of our projects has had a different operational structure to reflect that community's needs.
