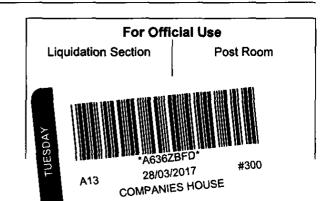

1 Introduction

- 1.1 I, Lynn Gibson of Gibson Hewitt Limited, 5 Park Court, Pyrford Road, West Byfleet, Surrey, KT14 6SD, was appointed as Liquidator of Rapid Litigation Management Limited ("the Company") on 29 September 2016. This report provides a summary of the outcome of the liquidation of the Company which has now been completed.
- 1.2 The trading address of the Company was C/o Harwood Capital LLP, 6 Stratton Street, London, W1J 8LD. The business traded under the name Rapid Litigation Management Limited.
- 1.3 The registered office of the Company was changed to 5 Park Court, Pyrford Road, West Byfleet, Surrey, KT14 6SD and its registered number is 9629181.

2 Progress of the Liquidation

Cash at bank

- 2.1 The Declaration of Solvency showed a value of £24,204 with regards to cash held at bank. This was realised in full by bank transfer.
- 2.2 At the date of liquidation, the Company had a debt of \$6,529,406 repayable by the shareholders with the split of that debt being proportionate to their holdings in the Company. This debt was satisfied by a Distribution in Specie to members with a distribution of £5,039,396, as converted on 30 September 2016, which compares to the £4,992,384 estimated value as calculated on the Directors' Declaration of Solvency prior to the liquidation.
- 2.3 At Appendix A, I have provided an account of my Receipts and Payments for the period ended 23 January 2017 with a comparison to the Declaration of Solvency. Appendix B provides details of the remuneration charged and expenses incurred and paid by the Liquidator during the period of this report.
 - Further information on the Liquidator's remuneration can be found in section 6 below.

3 Outcome for Creditors

Preferential Creditors

3.1 There were no preferential creditors in this liquidation.

Unsecured Creditors

- 3.2 I received a claim from HMRC totalling £8,318.
- 3.3 I can confirm that HMRC was paid in full.

4 Distributions to Members

- 4.1 The following cash distributions to members have been made:
 - A first dividend being a Distribution in Specie of £5,039,396 being £1.2029 per £1 share on 30 August 2016
 - A second and final dividend of £5,934 being £0.001416 per £1 share on 17
 January 2017
 - The cumulative return to members was £5,045,330 being £1.2043 per £1 share

5 Liquidator's Remuneration

- 5.1 The Members approved that the basis of the Liquidator's remuneration and disbursements be fixed at £8,000 plus VAT at the meeting of members held on 29 September 2016. All fees have been taken and no further fees will be billed to this liquidation.

6 Members' Rights

- 6.1 Within 21 days of the receipt of this report, members with either at least 5% of the total voting rights of all the members having the right to vote at general meetings of the Company or with the permission of the court, may request in writing that the Liquidator provide further information about his remuneration or expenses which have been itemised in this progress report.
- Any members with at least 10% of the total voting rights of all the members having the right to vote at general meetings of the Company may within 8 weeks of receipt of this progress report, make an application to court on the grounds that, in all the circumstances, the basis fixed for the Liquidator's remuneration is inappropriate and/or the remuneration charged or the expenses incurred by the Liquidator, as set out in this progress report, are excessive.

7 Notice of Final Meeting of Members

- 7.1 Notice is hereby given pursuant to Section 94 of the Insolvency Act 1986 that a final meeting of Members of the Company will be held at 5 Park Court, Pyrford Road, West Byfleet, Surrey, KT14 6SD on 27 March 2017 at 10.30am for the purpose of receiving a final account of the Liquidator's acts and dealings and of the conduct of the winding up.
- 7.2 The following resolutions will be put to the meeting:
 - That the Receipts and Payment account for the duration of the case be approved
 - Liquidator's Report be approved; and
 - That the Liquidator be granted her release from office.
