### PROGRESS IN THE LIQUIDATION

#### Asset realisations

At the date of Liquidation, the Company had no known assets to realise nor are any listed on the Declaration of Solvency. As a result, there have been no receipts or payments in the Liquidation, as shown on the receipts and payments account attached at Appendix C.

#### **HMRC**
