1. **STATUTORY INFORMATION**

Euro Caps and Closures Limited is a private company, limited by shares, registered in England and Wales. The company's registered number is 09853605 and its registered office is Unit 5, Weston Interchange, Cowley Way, Crewe, CW1 6AG.

2. **ACCOUNTING POLICIES**

Basis of preparing the financial statements

These financial statements have been prepared in accordance with the provisions of Section 1A "Small Entities" of Financial Reporting Standard 102 "The Financial Reporting Standard applicable in the UK and Republic of Ireland" and the Companies Act 2006. The financial statements have been prepared under the historical cost convention.

Revenue recognition

Turnover is measured at the fair value of the consideration received or receivable.

Turnover represents the net invoiced sales of goods excluding value added tax from the provision of supply of caps and closures for bottles and containers.

Financial instruments

Debtors

Trade debtors and other debtors are recognised at the settlement amount due with appropriate allowances for any irrecoverable amounts when there is objective evidence that the asset is impaired.

Cash and cash equivalents

Cash and cash equivalents in the balance sheet comprise cash on hand and cash at bank with a short term of maturity, being twelve months or less, from the opening of the deposit or similar account.

Creditors

Trade creditors and other creditors are all recognised where the company has a present obligation resulting from a past event and are recognised at the settlement amount due after allowing for any trade discounts due.
