Chichester Forest Schools CIC provide forest school (and some beach school) experiences for children and families in the Chichester and surrounding area. We have worked with our community in the following ways.

- -Planning and delivering forest school and beach school programmes to primary and secondary schools in West Sussex and Hampshire areas.
- Running regular parent and pre-schooler sessions for families
- providing holiday sessions for children in the school holidays.

We have successfully raised £20,000 grant money from National lottery Awards for All, West Sussex County Council Community Initiative Fund, Chichester City Council and the NINEVEH Charitable trust. These moneys are to support our work with disadvantaged young people with emotional and behavioural needs through the provision of long term nurture forest school programmes to build self-esteem, confidence and resilience. We have purchased equipment, trained another Forest school leader and delivered a successful pilot programme. In September 2017 we began delivering our nurture programmes to primary and secondary children.

We have also raised additional funds through running a "Dark Sky's" event with Natural England at Kingley Vale Nature Reserve and have been awarded a Tesco's grant which has been used to fund pre-school sessions for disadvantaged children at a local pre-school.
