1. **STATUTORY INFORMATION**

Arista Kids Ltd is a private company, limited by shares, registered in England and Wales. The company's registered number and registered office address can be found on the Company Information page.

The presentation currency of the financial statements is the Pound Sterling (£).

2. **ACCOUNTING POLICIES**

Basis of preparing the financial statements

These financial statements have been prepared in accordance with Financial Reporting Standard 102 "The Financial Reporting Standard applicable in the UK and Republic of Ireland" including the provisions of Section 1A "Small Entities" and the Companies Act 2006. The financial statements have been prepared under the historical cost convention.

Going concern

The accounts have been prepared on a going concern basis.

The director is aware of material uncertainties that cast doubt on the company's ability to continue as a going concern. As with most businesses, these material uncertainties are in relation to the ongoing Covid-19 virus outbreak which has had an impact on the operations, customers, suppliers and staff. The director has (where appropriate) utilised the grants and benefits available from the government and are taking all the steps they can to protect the future of the business.

The director has also prepared a cash flow forecast for the period to February 2021 and on this basis believe that the company has sufficient facilities to meet its liabilities as they fall due for the foreseeable future, and specifically for a period of not less than 12 months from the date of the signing of these financial statements. The director therefore considers the preparation of the financial statements on a going concern basis to be appropriate

Turnover

Turnover is measured at the fair value of the consideration received or receivable, excluding discounts, rebates, value added tax and other sales taxes.

Tangible fixed assets

Depreciation is provided at the following annual rates in order to write off each asset over its estimated useful life.

Office Equipment - 25% reducing balance

Fixtures & Fittings - 25% reducing balance

Taxation

Taxation for the period comprises current and deferred tax. Tax is recognised in the Income Statement, except to the extent that it relates to items recognised in other comprehensive income or directly in equity.

Current or deferred taxation assets and liabilities are not discounted.

Current tax is recognised at the amount of tax payable using the tax rates and laws that have been enacted or substantively enacted by the statement of financial position date.
