

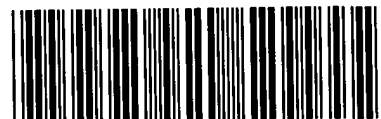



NOTES TO THE FINANCIAL STATEMENTS
for the Year Ended 31 August 2020

1. **STATUTORY INFORMATION**

Chorley School Sport Partnership CIC is a private company, limited by guarantee, registered in England and Wales. The company's registered number and registered office address can be found on the Company Information page.

2. **ACCOUNTING POLICIES**

Basis of preparing the financial statements

These financial statements have been prepared in accordance with Financial Reporting Standard 102 "The Financial Reporting Standard applicable in the UK and Republic of Ireland" including the provisions of Section 1A "Small Entities" and the Companies Act 2006. The financial statements have been prepared under the historical cost convention.

Income

Income is recognised when the company legally entitled to it after any performance conditions have been met and services provided to the members the sports partnership.

Tangible fixed assets

Depreciation is provided at the following annual rates in order to write off each asset over its estimated useful life.

Taxation

Taxation for the year comprises current and deferred tax. Tax is recognised in the Income Statement, except to the extent that it relates to items recognised in other comprehensive income or directly in equity.

Current or deferred taxation assets and liabilities are not discounted.

Current tax is recognised at the amount of tax payable using the tax rates and laws that have been enacted or substantively enacted by the balance sheet date.

Deferred tax

Deferred tax is recognised in respect of all timing differences that have originated but not reversed at the balance sheet date.

Timing differences arise from the inclusion of income and expenses in tax assessments in periods different from those in which they are recognised in financial statements. Deferred tax is measured using tax rates and laws that have been enacted or substantively enacted by the year end and that are expected to apply to the reversal of the timing difference.

Unrelieved tax losses and other deferred tax assets are recognised only to the extent that it is probable that they will be recovered against the reversal of deferred tax liabilities or other future taxable profits.

Hire purchase and leasing commitments

Rentals paid under operating leases are charged to surplus or deficit on a straight line basis over the period of the lease.

Pension costs and other post-retirement benefits

The company operates a defined contribution pension scheme. Contributions payable to the company's pension scheme are charged to profit or loss in the period to which they relate.

Chorley School Sport Partnership had a strange year with COVID closing schools in March 2020. Pre COVID we managed to deliver some of our usual annual activities including;

- " Taught 6500 Children PE
- " Delivered 39 events and competitions for 4550 young people
- " Introduced 10 weekly virtual competitions and involved 25 schools and 642 families each week.
- " Upskill 80 teachers and support staff
- " Recruited and trained 658 Leader and supported a further 67 to become volunteers
- " Provide national "on road" bike training to 527 year 5&6 students
- " Delivered new commute training to 46 secondary students enabling them to travel to school safely
- " Introduced biking to 743 reception children learning how to balance on 2 wheels


