### PART 1 - GENERAL DESCRIPTION OF THE COMPANY'S ACTIVITIES AND IMPACT

The Mental Wellbeing Centre began working with the NHS in 2020 to provide mental health support to local residents. In the last financial year, our activities have benefitted our community in the following ways:

- We have provided online one-to-one sessions with over 200 local families to support and resolve mental health disorders.
- We have supported GPs and Social Prescribers to create new interventions in the local community to support and promote good mental health and wellbeing.
- We have delivered talks on mental health and wellbeing to local schools and Rotary Clubs.
- We have been invited to speak at international family wellbeing conferences in light of the work we have done in Bishops Stortford and the surrounding areas.

### PART 2 - CONSULTATION WITH STAKEHOLDERS

Our stakeholders are the patients of Stort Valley and Villages Primary Care Network and their Doctor's surgeries. The directors of the Mental Wellbeing Centre live in the area they serve, and as such, have a good understanding of the mental health needs and struggles of the local residents. Patients are asked to complete a short questionnaire when they begin one-to-one sessions with us, and this helps us to tailor our service to meet their specific needs. Meetings with GPs and wider support teams are regular and ongoing, and this includes a weekly meeting with our Clinical Director and lead Young People's Social Prescriber: this ensures that we are constantly providing useful and effective support to GPs and that our standard of care towards our patients remains constantly high. We also undertake regular supervision sessions with the lead psychotherapist in this area where we can discuss specific cases and issues; this process helps to support the quality of the service we provide.
