



ARTICLES OF ASSOCIATION OF

OINOUSSAI BENEVOLENT FUND

1. PRELIMINARY

- 1.1 These Articles, together with the articles contained in Schedule 2 to the Companies (Model Articles) Regulations 2008 ("**Model Articles**") shall be the Articles of Association of the Company (the "**Articles**") save insofar as the Model Articles are excluded, varied or added to hereby.
- 1.2 In these Articles terms defined in the Model Articles which are not otherwise defined in these Articles shall have the same meaning in these Articles unless the contrary intention appears.
- 1.3 In these Articles, any reference to a provision of the Companies Act 2006 shall be deemed to include a reference to any statutory modification or re-enactment of that provision for the time being in force.
- 1.4 The headings used in these Articles are included for the sake of convenience only and shall be ignored in construing the language or meaning of these Articles.
- 1.5 In these Articles, unless the context otherwise requires, references to nouns in the plural form shall be deemed to include the singular and vice versa, references to one gender include all genders and references to persons include bodies corporate and unincorporated associations.

2. OBJECTS

- 2.1 The following should be inserted as a new Part 1 A:

2A The objects for which the Company is established are specifically restricted to raising charitable funds for the relief of poverty and for the educational needs of the inhabitants of the island of Oinoussai, Greece (the "**Objects**").

3. VOTING AT GENERAL MEETINGS

Voting: One Member one vote

28A. On a show of hands or on a poll, every Member whether an individual or an organisation, shall have one vote.

4. NON DISTRIBUTION TO MEMBERS

Non Distribution to Members

33A. The income and property of the Company shall only be applied to promote the Objects. No part of the income or property of the Company may be paid or transferred directly or indirectly by way of dividend, bonus or otherwise by way of profit to any Member of the Company.

5. ADMINSTRATIVE ARRANGEMENTS

- 5.1 The following should be inserted as new Article 37A:

Winding Up

37A On the winding-up or dissolution of the Company, after provision has been made for all its debts and liabilities, any assets or property that remains available to be distributed or paid, shall not be paid or distributed to the Members but shall be transferred to another body in any of the following ways:

- (a) Directly for the Objects;
- (b) By transfer to any charity or charities for use for particular purposes similar to the Objects; or
- (c) To any charity or charities for use for particular purposes that fall within the Objects.

Such body to be determined by resolution of the Members at or before the time of winding up or dissolution and, subject to any such resolution of the Members, may be made by resolution of the directors at or before the time of winding up or dissolution. If no such resolution is passed by the members or the directors the net assets of the charity shall be applied for charitable purposes as directed by the Courts of England and Wales or the Charity Commission.
