1. STATUTORY INFORMATION

Connex Education Partnership Warrington Limited is a private company, limited by shares, registered in England and Wales. The company's registered number is 11412187 and the registered office address is Unit A Telford Court, Chester Gates Business Park, Chester, Cheshire, CH1 6LT.

2. ACCOUNTING POLICIES

Basis of preparing the financial statements

These financial statements have been prepared in accordance with Financial Reporting Standard 102 "The Financial Reporting Standard applicable in the UK and Republic of Ireland" including the provisions of Section 1A "Small Entities" and the Companies Act 2006. The financial statements have been prepared under the historical cost convention.

The directors have considered the impact of the global Covid-19 pandemic on the company and recognise that the future cannot be predicted with certainty. The company commenced to trade following the year end and to date, has remained operational with policies in place to ensure all workers are working safely and in accordance with government guidelines. Should demand for the company's services fall, the company would introduce cost control measures and would make use of any government funding available to them. The directors believe that the company is well placed to manage the risks at these challenging times and therefore continues to adopt a going concern basis of accounting in preparing these financial statements.

Significant judgements and estimates

There are currently no significant judgements and estimates applied by the directors which are considered key to the preparation of the financial statements.

Taxation

Taxation for the year comprises current and deferred tax. Tax is recognised in the Income Statement, except to the extent that it relates to items recognised in other comprehensive income or directly in equity.

Current or deferred taxation assets and liabilities are not discounted.

Current tax is recognised at the amount of tax payable using the tax rates and laws that have been enacted or substantively enacted by the statement of financial position date.

Deferred tax

Deferred tax is recognised in respect of all timing differences that have originated but not reversed at the statement of financial position date.

Timing differences arise from the inclusion of income and expenses in tax assessments in periods different from those in which they are recognised in financial statements. Deferred tax is measured using tax rates and laws that have been enacted or substantively enacted by the year end and that are expected to apply to the reversal of the timing difference.

Unrelieved tax losses and other deferred tax assets are recognised only to the extent that it is probable that they will be recovered against the reversal of deferred tax liabilities or other future taxable profits.

Dividends

Equity dividends are recognised when they become legally payable and are no longer at the discretion of the company.
