ARTICLES OF ASSOCAITION OF

ALLSAINTS INTERNATIONAL FOUNDATION-UK (AIF-UK)

1. Introduction

There is hereby-established an association to be known as **Allsaints International Foundation –UK (AIF-UK)**

The registered office of the organisation shall be in England at an address to be specified by the Executive Board of the association.

Allsaints International Foundation –UK (AIF-UK) is a non-political organisation.

Allsaints International Foundation –UK (AIF-UK) shall be non-profit making and all its income shall be applied solely towards the attainment of its objectives.

Objects

The charity's objects are to strengthen and empower disadvantaged families and communities through social enterprise and self help initiatives; to promote community integration in the United Kingdom and other parts of the world. To develop employability skills through training, education and volunteering opportunities so as to reduce social and economic inequalities among the most disadvantaged families and communities living in the most deprived sections of society both in United Kingdom, and other parts of the world. To support communities through intensive self-help volunteering activities; working together with people from all generations to make a change in both their lives and the community they live in. Getting together people of all ages and abilities with a heart to motivate others, and encouraging them to take an active role in the community, as well as working together towards building-up strong communities, and supporting others in need.

In furtherance of the objects but not otherwise the Executive Committee / Directors are responsible for the management of the organization's business, for which purpose they may exercise all the powers of the organization.

- 3.1 Such a decision may take the form of a resolution in writing, copies of which have been signed by each eligible director or to which each eligible director has otherwise indicated agreement in writing.
- 3.2 References in this article to eligible directors are to directors who would have been entitled to vote on the matter had it been proposed as a resolution at a directors' meeting.
- 3.3 A decision may not be taken in accordance with this article if the eligible directors would not have formed a quorum at such a meeting.

Powers

Powers to raise funds and to invite and receive contributions provided that in raising funds the Executive Committee shall not undertake any substantial permanent trading activities and shall conform to any relevant requirements of the law

Powers to provide advocacy and support, advice and information to socially deprived families, mostly vulnerable members of the ethnic minority and other disadvantaged groups on issues such as, welfare rights, housing, education and training, employment, legal rights and immigration matters, health promotion, refugee integration, social and personal matters

Powers to identify existing training schemes and to create new ways for a sustainable, health and economically viable living for the impoverished communities in the United Kingdom, and around the world

Powers to alleviate poverty and stress in the community through social enterprise projects

Powers to promote self reliance, build public awareness of healthy lifestyle, develop skills, build confidence and update existing skills. To challenge sexist attitudes by emphasizing a positive image among the poorest communities.

Powers to carry out training programmes and information dissemination, and to provide care and support for those living with long term illnesses, mental health and stress related illnesses

Powers to buy, take on lease or in exchange any property necessary for the achievement of the objects and to maintain and equip it for use

Powers subject to any consent required by law to sell, lease, and dispose of all or any part of the property of the charity

Powers subject to any consent required by the law to borrow money and charge all or any part of the property of the charity with repayment of the money so borrowed

Powers to employ such staff who shall not be members of the Executive Committee as is necessary for the proper pursuit of the objects

Powers to cooperate with other charities, voluntary bodies and statutory authorities operating in furtherance of the objects or of similar charitable purposes and to exchange information and advice with them

Powers to establish or support any charities trusts, associations or institutions formed for all or any of the objects

Powers to appoint and constitute such advisory committees as the Executive Committee may think fit

Powers to do all such other lawful things as are necessary for the achievement of the objects

Membership of the Organisation

- 4.1 Membership of the charity shall be open to any person over the age of 18 years interested in furthering the objects and who has paid the annual subscription laid down from time to time by the Executive Committee.
- 4.2 Every member shall have one vote.
- 4.3 The Executive Committee may by unanimous vote and for good reasons terminate the membership of any individual; provided that the individual concerned shall have the right to be heard by the Executive Committee, accompanied by a friend, before a final decision is made.

Membership

5.1 The rights of the members;

To attend the meetings of the organisation and to vote in such meetings

To contest for positions of the committee of the organisation following an established democratic criteria and

To participate in the activities of the organisation

5.2 The duties of the members;

To pay annual subscription fee of ten pounds or such amount as shall be determined from time to time by the Assembly or the Executive

To promote the organisation and its aims and objectives

To participate in the activities of the organisation

Administration

Subject to the matters set out below the Charity and its property shall be administered and managed in accordance with this constitution by the members of the Executive Committee of this organisation.

Executive Committee

The Executive Committee shall consist of not less than 4 members or more than 10 members being:

The honorary officers specified in the proceeding clause

Not less than 3 and not more 9 members elected at the annual meeting whom shall hold office from the conclusion of that meeting

The Executive Committee may in addition appoint not more than 2 co-opted members but so that no-one maybe appointed as co-opted member, as a result, more than one third of the members of the Executive Committee would be co-opted members. Each appointment of the co-opted member shall be made at a special meeting of the Executive Committee, and shall be affected at the end of that meeting, unless the appointment is to fill a place in which case the appointment shall run from the date when the post becomes vacant.

All the members of the Executive Committee shall retire from office together at the end of annual general meeting next after the date on which they came into office but may be re-elected or re-appointed.

The proceedings of the Executive Committee shall not be invalidated by any defect in the appointment or qualification of a member.

Nobody shall be appointed as a member of the Executive Committee who is aged less than 18 years or who would if appointed be disqualified under the provision of the following clause.

No person shall be entitled to act as a member of the Executive Committee whether on first or in any subsequent entry into office until after signing in the minute book of the Executive Committee a declaration of acceptance and of willingness to act in trusts of the Organisation.

The Executive Committee may appoint such special or standing Committees as may be deemed necessary by the Committee and shall determine their terms of reference, powers, duration and composition. All acts and proceedings of such special or standing committees shall be reported back to the Executive Committee as soon as possible.

Executive Committee (Interests)

No member of the Executive Committee shall acquire any interest in property belonging to the Charity (Otherwise than as a trustee of the charity) or receive remuneration, or to be interested (otherwise than as a member of the Executive Committee) in any contract entered into by the Executive Committee.

Liability of members

The liability of the members is limited to £1, being the amount that each member undertakes to contribute the assets of the company in the event of it's being wound up while he/she is a member or within one year after he/she ceases to be a member For-

- (a) Payment of the company's debts and liabilities contracted before he/she ceases to be a member
- (b) Payment of costs, charges and expenses of winding up, and
- (c) Adjustments of the rights of the contributories among themselves

Receipts and Expenditure of Funds

The company is non-profit making and all its income shall be applied solely towards the attainment of its objectives. The funds of the organisation including all profits, donations and contributions should be used to further the objects of company and not paid to the members as dividends.

The funds belonging to the company shall be applied only in furthering of the objects.

Property

Subject to the provisions off sub-clause (b) of this clause, the Executive Committee shall cause the title to:

All land held by or in trust for the organisation which is not vested in the Official Custodian for Charities; and

All investments held by or on behalf of the Organisation;

To be vested either in a corporation entitled to act as custodian trustees or in not less than three individuals appointed by them as holding trustees.

Holding trustees may be removed by the Executive Committee at their pleasure and shall act in accordance with the lawful direction the Executive Committee, the holding trustees shall not be liable for the acts and defaults of its members.

Accounts

The Executive Committee shall comply with the accounting requirements of the Charities Act 1993 (or any statutory re-accounting re-enactment or modification of the Act regards to;

Annual Report

The Executive Committee shall comply with the obligations under the Charities Act 1993 (or any statutory re-enactment of modification of that Act) with regards to preparation of an annual return and its transmission to the Commissioners.

Annual Return

The Executive Committee shall comply with the obligations under the Charities Act 1993 (or any statutory re-enactment or modification of that Act) with regards to preparation of annual return and its transmission to the Commissioners.

Annual General Meeting

There shall be an annual general meeting of the Organisation which shall be held in the month of June in each year or as soon as practicable thereafter.

The Chairperson of the Committee may at any time at his/her discretion and the General Secretary shall within 21 days of receiving a written request to do so, signed by not less than three members whether un individual or a representative, and giving reasons for the request, call a special meeting of the Organisation.

Rules of Procedure at all Meetings

Quorum – the quorum at a meeting of the Organisation or of the Committee or any committee appointed under clause 6 (7) shall be one-third of the total for the time being.

Voting —save as otherwise herein provided, all questions arising at any meeting shall be decided by a simple majority of those present and are entitled to vote. No one person shall exercise more than one vote. In case of an equality of votes the chairperson of the meeting shall have a second or casting vote.

The management shall keep minutes

The Committee and other committees, and the appropriate secretary shall enter therein a record of all proceedings and resolutions.

15. Alteration to Constitution

Subject to the following provisions of this clause,

The Constitution may be altered by a resolution passed by not less than two thirds of members eligible to vote at a general meeting. The notice of the general meeting must include notice of the resolution, setting out the terms of alteration proposed.

No amendments may be made to clause (1) (The name of the organisation clause), clause (2) (The objects clause), Clause (8) (Executive Committee (interests) clause), or this clause without the prior consent in writing of the Commissioners.

No amendments may be made to clause (1) (The name of the organisation clause), clause (2) (The objects clause), Clause (8) (Executive Committee (interests) clause), or this clause without the prior consent in writing of the Commissioners.

No amendments may be made which would have the effect of making the Organisation cease to be a charity.

The Executive Committee should promptly send to the Commission a copy of any amendment(s) made under this clause.

16. Dissolution

If the Executive Committee decides that it is necessary or advisable to dissolve the charity it shall call a meeting of all members of the charity, of which not less than 21 days' notice (stating the terms of the resolution to be proposed) shall be given. If the proposal is confirmed by a two-thirds majority of those present and voting the Executive Committee shall have powers to release any assets held by or on behalf of the charity.

Any assets remaining after the satisfaction of any proper debts and liabilities shall be given or transferred to such other charitable institution or institutions having objects similar to the charity as the members of the charity may determine or failing that shall be applied for some other charitable purpose. A copy of the statement of accounts, or account and statement, for the final accounting period of the charity must be sent to the Commission.

17. Arrangements until first Annual General Meeting

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Until the first Annual General Meeting takes place, this constitution shall take effect as if reference in it to the Executive Committee were references to the persons whose signatures appear at the bottom of this document.
