2 Summary of the matters dealt with during the course of the liquidation

- 2.1 This account should be read in conjunction with my receipts and payments account, which is attached as Appendix 1; please note that the figures are shown net of VAT. Please also note that I am obliged to confirm to you that my receipts and payments account has been reconciled to the account held by the Secretary of State. In this case, no funds were held by the Secretary of State therefore no account can be reconciled.
- 2.2 As noted in my receipts and payments account, realisations are broadly in line with the Declaration of Solvency. Further detail is provided below.

Amounts owed by group undertakings

- 2.3 The Company's final balance sheet as at 8 December 2022 detailed an amount owed by group undertakings of \$1.00 as a balancing figure to the issued share capital of 2 Ordinary \$1.00 shares and equity of -\$1.00.
- 2.4 The figures on the final balance sheet were converted from US Dollars into Pound Sterling for the purpose of the Declaration and Solvency. The Declaration of Solvency detailed an amount owed by group undertakings of £1.00 as a balancing figure to the share capital of 2 Ordinary £1.00 shares and equity of -£1.00. As you will note from Appendix 1, equity is not detailed in the receipts and payments account.

2.5 As part of my administration of the estate, I have to meet various legislative and best practice requirements and deadlines. - 5.2 A resolution was passed by the shareholder on 8 December 2022 to agree my remuneration on a fixed fee basis in the sum of £4,500 plus VAT and disbursements. My remuneration is not detailed on the attached receipts and payments account as it was paid directly by Silvergate Media Holdings Limited.
