We are driven by listening to the issue young people today face and through participation and consultation at our community groups or our in schools projects give young people a safe environment to be listened to. We work in partnership with other organisations and not for profit organisations with the same values and goals to provide opportunities for young people and communities living in Fenland. As a socially responsible provider, we endeavour to reach out to as many people as we can.. To do this, we take great strides to ensure our staff are well-trained and provide help through meaningful activities that will improve the quality of lives of young people and the community they live in We support young people to become involved in volunteering and our mentor project. Over the past 12 months and the impact of COVID 19 we have adapted to also provide Outreach and Detached youth work to meet with and support as many young people as possible during the pandemic. Young people have had an increase in issues with mental health, Socially and rurall isolation and dealing with added stress, worry and pressure with the pandemic and not having the support of direct contact with daily school life. We have worked with County council, Distric council and local authorities to target areas that have had an increase in Anti social behaviour we worked with those young people to educated about thier community and have had feedback of a reduction in Anti social behaviour with our intervention.
