#### **ORDER**

**UPON** hearing Miss Carroll, Counsel for the Applicants

**AND UPON** the Applicants' application dated 31 August 2023 for relief from sanctions and to rescind the winding up order dated 18 July 2023 ('the Application')

**AND UPON** the parties having agreed by consent that Pacific Brands Limited be added as an applicant to the proceedings

### IT IS ORDERED THAT:

- 1. Pacific Brands Limited be added as an applicant to these proceedings pursuant to CPR r19.2.(2)(a).
- 2. The Applicants are granted an extension of time pursuant to CPR r3.1(2)(a).
- 3. The winding up order dated 18 July 2023 made by District Judge Obodai is rescinded.
- 4. The petition dated 18 April 2023 is dismissed.
- 5. The Registrar of Companies do remove any notice of the winding up order from the company's records at Companies House and do record that the winding up order was rescinded, and the petition dismissed.
- 6. The Official Receiver shall retain the £2,600 petition deposit to partially cover the liquidation administration fee.
