WRITTEN RESOLUTION

of

Legacy Park Developments Limited ("Company")

23RD NOVEMBER 2020 ("Circulation Date")

Pursuant to Chapter 2 of Part 13 of the Companies Act 2006, the directors of the Company propose that the resolutions below are passed as ordinary and special resolutions respectively ("**Resolutions**");

ORDINARY RESOLUTIONS:

1. AUTHORITY TO ALLOT

THAT, in accordance with section 551 of the CA 2006 the directors of the Company ("**Directors**") be generally and unconditionally authorised to allot up to 99 ordinary shares of £1.00 each in the Company and 48 A Preference Shares of £1.00 each in the capital of the Company (together the "**Allotment Shares**") provided that this authority shall, unless renewed, varied or revoked by the Company, expire on 30 March 2021 save that the Company may, before such expiry, make an offer or agreement which would or might require shares to be allotted and the Directors may allot shares in pursuance of such offer or agreement notwithstanding that the authority conferred by this resolution has expired.

This authority is in substitution for all previous authorities conferred on the Directors in accordance with section 551 of the CA 2006 but without prejudice to any allotment of shares or grant of Rights already made or offered or agreed to be made pursuant to such authorities.

2. DISAPPLICATION OF PRE-EMPTION RIGHTS

THAT, subject to the passing of resolution 1 and in accordance with section 570 of the CA 2006 and the Company's articles of association, the Directors be generally

empowered to allot shares (as defined in section 560 of the CA 2006) pursuant to the authority conferred by resolution 1, as if section 561(1) of the CA 2006 nor any pre-emption rights in the Company's articles of association apply to any such allotment, provided that this power shall:

- a) be limited to the allotment of the Allotment Shares; and
- b) expire on 30 March 2021 (unless renewed, varied or revoked by the Company prior to or on that date), save that the Company may, before such expiry, make an offer or agreement which would or might require shares to be allotted after such expiry and the Directors may allot shares in pursuance of any such offer or agreement notwithstanding that the power conferred by this resolution has expired.

SPECIAL RESOLUTIONS:

ADOPTION OF NEW ARTICLES OF ASSOCIATION


THAT the draft articles of association attached to this resolution be adopted as the articles of association of the Company in substitution for and to the exclusion of the existing articles of association.
