n April 2020, with the national lockdown in place and schools closed for the first time in UK history, parents across the country were navigating how to keep their children educated and their families stimulated, entertained and connected. Since our launch, Power to Connect has delivered over 1,600 devices to 72 Wandsworth Schools for local families to keep.
