With the ending of pandemic restrictions the company was able to hold the annual community Advent Market Christmas fair in the redundant church of St John's in Duxford. This event is intended to be an open and free event for the village community, hosting local craft stalls and refreshment stands. Several stalls raise funds for local community good causes.

The 2022 event was held over one day in December and made a marginal profit after operating costs.
