#### Company activities and impact

Be The Change supports young people from across Bolton aged from 11-25 to reach their full potential. We are particularly successful in engaging with young people from diverse communities who do not attend mainstream youth provision. There are two main strands to our offer. We deliver regular, accessible, and affordable sports provisions including football, basketball, and boxing. We also offer regular drop-in youth club nights, including regular girls-only provision, with a wider range of activities including informal games and chill-out space, arts, and creative writing. Our organization is well networked in the youth and sports sectors across the region and we are able to link with other partners to offer a wider range of activities such as outdoor adventure sports, and we signpost youngpeople to training, employment, and sports opportunities including good links with football club academies. We have also developed workshops to address issues of knife crime and gun culture and we take these into schools and other settings.

#### Consultation with stakeholders

We run regular online surveys with young people and members of the community to enable them to provide confidential and anonymous feedback on Be The Change's activities and make suggestions. Feedback from our beneficiary help us to shape our work on the activities and the support we provide, We also deliver creative focus groups to ensure that young people have input into the design of our programs. We have a youth committee made up of six young people.
