The trustees present their report and financial statements for the period ended 31 December 2021.

The financial statements have been prepared in accordance with the accounting policies set out in note 1 to the financial statements and comply with the charity's Memorandum and Articles of Association, the Companies Act 2006 and the Statement of Recommended Practice: Accounting and Reporting by Charities preparing their accounts in accordance with the Financial Reporting Standard applicable in the UK and Republic of Ireland (FRS 102) second edition (effective 1 January 2019).

Objectives and activities

The charity's objects are for the advancement of education for the public benefit through the encouragement and support, financially or otherwise, of innovation and learning, in particular for those who are in need as a result of financial or any other disadvantage, by: (a) the promotion, improvement and development of leadership and management skills; and (b) the provision, encouragement and promotion of education and the skills needed in employment, instruction or training in professions, vocations, industries, crafts, or trades.

The trustees have paid due regard to guidance on public benefit issued by the Charity Commission in deciding what activities the charity should undertake.

Achievements and performance

The charity was incorporated on 2 June 2021 and has not undertaken any activities during the period.

Financial review

The charity has not undertaken any activities during the period and held no funds at 31 December 2021, the charity has been active in the period since the year end and these funds will be reflected on in the next financial year.

A reserves policy has been implemented and when charitable activity commences the target level of reserves has been set such that the free reserves should total 12 months of total organisational operating costs based on the next budget year. This should be regularly reviewed to ensure that it meets the Charity's changing needs and circumstances.

The charity is a company limited by guarantee and governed by its Memorandum and Articles of Association dated 2 June 2021.

1 Accounting policies

Charity information

The PA Foundation is a private company limited by guarantee incorporated in England and Wales. The registered office is 10 Bressenden Place, London, SW1E 5DN, United Kingdom.

Accounting convention

The financial statements have been prepared in accordance with the charity's Memorandum and Articles of Association, the Companies Act 2006 and the Statement of Recommended Practice: Accounting and Reporting by Charities preparing their accounts in accordance with the Financial Reporting Standard applicable in the UK and Republic of Ireland (FRS 102) second edition (effective 1 January 2019).

The financial statements are prepared in sterling, which is the functional currency of the charity. Monetary amounts in these financial statements are rounded to the nearest £.

Reporting period

The annual financial statements are presented for a period shorter than one year. The charity was incorporated on 2 June 2021 and is preparing its first set of financial statements for the seven month period to 31 December 2021. As this is the first period there are no comparative figures so comparability is not affected.

Going concern

At the time of approving the financial statements, the trustees have a reasonable expectation that the charity has adequate resources to continue in operational existence for the foreseeable future. Thus the trustees continue to adopt the going concern basis of accounting in preparing the financial statements.
