AND UPON HEARING counsel, Miss Eleanor Temple, for the Applicant

AND UPON READING the sixth witness statement of William Matthew Humphries Tait dated 27 June 2022 and exhibit thereto, and the first witness statement of Francis Graham Newton dated 5 August 2022 and exhibit thereto

AND UPON reading the letters to all known creditors of the College dated 15 June 2022 and 20 July 2022

AND UPON Marpaul Southern Limited, a creditor of the College attending the hearing but not making any representations

AND UPON the creditors of the College not objecting to the relief sought and no other creditor of the College attending or being represented at the hearing

AND UPON the Secretary of State ("SoS') confirming by way of a letters dated 20 June 2022 that it does not object to the remuneration application and that the SoS will fund the Remuneration fixed and approved by the court in accordance with the Third Funding Agreement dated 26 April 2021 and that the SoS consents to the application to end the administration

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. The Applicants' appointment as joint education administrators shall cease to have effect pursuant to paragraph 79(1) of Schedule B1 to the Insolvency Act 1986 (the "Act") (as applied by paragraph 1 of Schedule 3 to the Technical and Further Education Act 2017("TFEA") and as modified by paragraph 23 of Schedule 3 to TFEA) with immediate effect;

The Applicants be discharged from liability in respect of any action as education administrators
pursuant to paragraph 98(1) of Schedule B1 to the Act (as applied by paragraph 1 of Schedule 3
to TFEA and as modified by paragraph 30 to Schedule 3 to TFEA) 28 days after filing their final
report to creditors;

- 3. The College is wound up and pursuant to paragraph 79(4)(d) of Schedule B1 to the Act (as applied by paragraph 1 of Schedule 3 to TFEA and as modified by paragraph 23 of Schedule 3), and pursuant to the court's inherent jurisdiction and section 140 of the Act (as applied by section 6 of TFEA), William Matthew Humphries Tait, Mark Patterson and Danny Nicolaas William Dartnaill ("Joint Liquidators") are appointed as joint liquidators of the College;
- 4. Any act required or authorised under any enactment to be done by a liquidator may be done by any or all of the Joint Liquidators pursuant to Section 231 of the Act;
- 5. The Applicants' remuneration from 24 April 2021 to 11 August 2022 ("Remuneration") is fixed and approved for payment pursuant to Rule 6.10(3) of The Education Administration Rules 2018 in the sum of £260,749.30 plus VAT;
- 6. The Applicants are entitled to receive the Remuneration forthwith.
- 7. The Applicants' pre-administration expenses in the sum of £4,089 (plus VAT) as detailed in the Witness Statement of Francis Graham Newton are approved for payment pursuant to Rule 6.11 EAR 2018. Any defect or irregularity in the payment of this sum prior to this approval is waived pursuant to Rule 4.41 EAR 2018;
- 8. The Applicants' cost of and occasioned by this Application shall be paid as expenses of the education administration pursuant to rule 3.36(1) of the Education Administration Rules 2018 out of the assets of the College.
