Notes to the abbreviated accounts for the year ended 31 July 2016

1. Accounting policies

The principle accounting policies are summarised below. The accounting policies have been applied consistently throughout the year and the preceding period.

1.1. Accounting convention

The accounts are prepared under the historical cost convention and in accordance with the Financial Reporting Standards for Smaller Entities (effective January 2015), the SORP 2005 'Accounting and Reporting by Charities: Statement of Recommended Practice' issued in March 2005 and the Companies Act 2006.

The company has taken advantage of the exemption in FRS1 from the requirement to produce a cashflow statement because it is a small company.

1.2. Incoming resources

All incoming resources are included in the statement of financial activities when the charity is entitled to the income and the amount can be quantified with reasonable accuracy. The following specific policies are applied to particular categories of income:

Voluntary income is received by way of grants, donations and gifts and is included in full in the statement of financial activities when receivable. Grants where entitlement is not conditional on the delivery of a specific performance by the charity, are recognised when the charity becomes unconditionally entitled to the grant.

Donated services and facilities are included at the value to the charity where this can be quantified. The value of services provided by volunteers has not been included.

Gifts donated for resale are included as incoming resources within activities for generating funds when they are sold.

1.3. Interest receivable

Interest is included when receivable by the company.

1.4. Resources expended

Expenditure is recognised on an accruals basis as a liability is incurred. Expenditure includes VAT which the company is ineligible to recover, and is reported as part of the expenditure to which it relates.

Charitable expenditure comprises those costs incurred by the charity in the delivery of its activities and services for its beneficiaries. It includes both costs that can be allocated directly to such activities and those costs of an indirect nature necessary to support them.

1.5. Tangible fixed assets and depreciation

Tangible fixed assets are stated at cost less accumulated depreciation.

Depreciation is provided at rates calculated to write off the cost less residual value of each asset over its expected useful life.

1.6. Fund accounting

Unrestricted funds relate to general funds which are available for use at the discretion of the trustees in furtherance of the general objectives of the charity and which have not been designated for other purposes.

Restricted funds are funds which are to be used in accordance with specific restrictions imposed by donors or which have been raised by the charity for particular purposes. The cost of raising and administering such funds are charged against the specific fund. The aim and use of each restricted fund is set out in the notes to the financial statements.

1.7. Taxation

The company is registered as a charity for tax purposes under reference XT21191.

As a charity, Donemana Cultural Association Limited is exempt from tax on income and gains falling within Section 505 of the Taxes Act 1988 or Section 256 of the Taxation of Chargeable Gains Act 1992 to the extent that these are applied to its charitable objects. No tax charges have therefore arisen for the company for the year ended 31 July 2016.
