


PART 1 - GENERAL DESCRIPTION OF THE COMPANY'S ACTIVITIES AND IMPACT

In its fifth year of operation, Education for Transfusion Practice (EFTP) facilitated (November 2019) the organisation, administration and running of another major regional educational meeting entitled "Focus on Patient Blood Management" which covered current topics in reducing blood transfusion relevant to Northern Ireland. In addition, the ongoing work of the NI Transfusion Committee was promoted to the wider transfusion community to increase knowledge and improve practice across several transfusion related matters.

The event attracted over 100 delegates from backgrounds of nursing, trainee doctors, senior clinicians, haemovigilance practitioners and laboratory staff. The conference was rated highly from the feedback obtained and facilitated increased relevant knowledge in transfusion related topics for the wider transfusion interested community across Northern Ireland.

Education for Transfusion Practice also continued to facilitate the minor expenses associated with the Northern Ireland Transfusion Committee regional meetings.
