During the current financial period the company was active as trade agent for consumer goods and received commission.

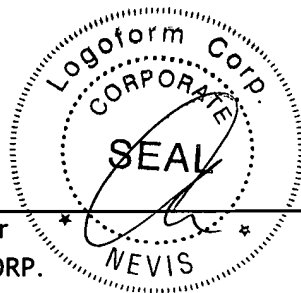
