1. Accounting policies

1.1 Basis of preparation of financial statements

These financial statements have been prepared in accordance with applicable United Kingdom accounting standards, including Financial Reporting Standard 102 – 'The Financial Reporting Standard applicable in the United Kingdom and Republic of Ireland' ('FRS 102'), and with the Companies Act 2006.

As the company is dormant it elected to retain its accounting policies for reported assets, liabilities and equity at the date of transition to FRS 102 until there is any change to those balances or the company undertakes any new transactions (as stated in paragraph 35.10(m) of the standard).

The following principal accounting policies have been applied consistently throughout the year and the preceding year.

1.2 Going concern

The company is a dormant company and therefore does not actively trade. After making enquiries, the directors have a reasonable expectation that the company has adequate resources to continue in operational existence for the foreseeable future. Another group company has committed to providing financial support to enable the company to meet its liabilities as they fall due.
