

The Lord Ordinary, having resumed consideration of the petition and proceedings, no answers having been lodged,

- allows the petition to be amended by inserting in the prayer of the petition the following: "(v) to appoint Christopher Richard Frederick Day and Nicholas Guy Edwards of Messrs Deloitte LLP, 66 Shoe Lane, London as joint Liquidators of the company in terms of section 108 of the Insolvency Act 1986;"; dispenses with intimation, service and advertisement of the petition as amended;
- 2. in terms of section 108 of the Insolvency Act 1986, appoints Christopher Richard Frederick Day and Nicholas Guy Edwards of Messrs Deloitte LLP, 66 Shoe Lane, London as joint Liquidators of Clydesdale Bank (Head Office) Nominees Limited;
- orders that Clydesdale Bank (Head Office) Nominees Limited, company number SC026263, be restored to the Register of Companies in terms of section 1031 of the Companies Act 2006 such restoration to take effect on a copy of this order being delivered to the Registrar;
- 4. orders the petitioners to deliver a certified copy of this order to the Registrar of Companies;
- 5. directs the Registrar of Companies to publish in the Edinburgh Gazette notice of the restoration of the company to the register; and
- 6. in terms of section 1032(3) of the Companies Act 2006, orders that in the case of creditors of the company to whom the company owed obligations which were not at the date of dissolution extinguished by prescription in terms of the Prescription and Limitation (Scotland) Act 1973, the period between the date of dissolution

and that of its restoration shall not be reckoned as part of any prescriptive period in terms of that Act;

7. authorises the expenses of this petition and the procedure following thereon, including any expenses to be paid to the Registrar of Companies or Queen's and Lord's Treasurers Remembrancer in connection with the proceedings for the restoration of the Company to the Register, to be paid out of the first and readiest funds of the Company.
