The Sheriff having resumed consideration of the foregoing Petition together with the productions produced, and having seen the Edinburgh Gazette dated 23rd august 2005 and the Herald newspaper dated 24th August 2005 each containing the intimation ordered by the preceding Interlocutor, no answers to said Petition having been lodged in Court, Finds (1) that the amount of the share capital of the said Clydesdale air Conditioning Limited paid up or credited as paid up does not exceed £120,000 (2) that the said Company is unable to pay its debts (3) that the said Company has by special resolution resolved that the Company be wound up by the Court.

Therefore Orders that the said Company having its registered Office at 72 North Vennel, Lanark ML11 be wound up in pursuance of the Insolvency Act, 1986: Nominates and Appoints James David Cockburn Macintyre to be the Interim Liquidator of the said Company with the usual powers, all in terms of said Statute and of Law. Finds the Petitioner entitled to the expenses of this Application as taxed by the Auditor of Court.
