1 INTRODUCTION AND STATUTORY INFORMATION

- 1.1 My partner, David K Hunter, and I were appointed joint administrators of Clydeview Precision Engineering and Supplies Limited ("the Company") on 18 November 2009. The application for the appointment of Administrators was made by the Directors of the Company with the knowledge of The Royal Bank of Scotland ("the Bank"), which holds a Qualifying Floating Charge. The appointment was made in terms of paragraph 22 of Schedule B1 of the Insolvency Act 1986 and notice was lodged at the Court of Session.
- 1.2 I enclose Form 2.20B (Scot) together with an account of my receipts and payments for the period from 18 May 2010 to 17 November 2010, in accordance with Rule 2.38 of the Insolvency (Scotland) Rules 1986.
- 1.3 In accordance with paragraph 100(2) of Schedule B1 to the Insolvency Act 1986, the functions of the administrators are to be exercised by any or all of them.
- 1.4 The registered number of the Company is SC102708. The Company traded from 197A Dumbarton Road, Clydebank, G81 4XJ. This address was also the registered office of the Company at the date of administration.

2 PROGRESS OF THE ADMINISTRATION

Assets

- 2.1 During this period I have collected in a further debtor balance outstanding of £2,886.50. All other book debts have been written off, either due to already having been paid, or due to a pre-Administration discount that was awarded.
- 2.2 Information provided in the Company books and records confirms that there is a director's loan account in the sum of £12,038.82. I have instructed legal agents and am pursuing the director concerned for full repayment of the sum due.

3 ADMINISTRATORS' REMUNERATION

3.1 The administrators' remuneration is determined in accordance with the Insolvency (Scotland) Rules 1986, as amended by the Enterprise Act 2002. In this case, it is anticipated that there will be funds available to unsecured creditors. Consequently, in accordance with Rule 2.39(9) of the Insolvency (Scotland) Rules 1986, the administrators' remuneration may be determined by the creditors' committee or if there is no committee, by the creditors. Our fee in the sum of £37,887.50 plus outlays of £842.91

for the period 18 November 2009 to 17 May 2010 was approved by creditors and drawn from available funds.

- 3.2 Separately the joint administrators' received a fee of £6,500, as approved and paid by the Bank, in relation specifically to the sale of the two properties secured to them. Fees have been drawn from the Fixed Charge proceeds received from the sale of the 197 and 197A Dumbarton Road, Clydebank and 24 Bellside Road, Cleland.
- 4 DISTRIBUTION TO PREFERENTIAL CREDITORS, SECURED CREDITORS AND FLOATING CHARGE HOLDER
- 4.1 The Bank received a distribution from the sale proceeds under its Standard Security held over 197 and 197A Dumbarton Road, Clydebank and 24 Bellside Road, Cleland. The balance due to the Bank at the date of administration stood at approximately £261,619.
- 4.2 The claims of the former employees, which ranked preferentially, have been adjudicated and have been paid in full.

5 ENDING THE ADMINISTRATION

- 5.1 The administration will come to an automatic end on 17 November 2010, being the anniversary of our appointment. It is necessary to extend the administration to allow the pursuit of the loan account balance due by one of the directors. I wish to submit an application to Court as no objection has been raised by creditors of the Company.
- 5.2 In the event that there are sufficient floating charge realisations, net of costs, available to enable payment of a dividend to ordinary creditors, the administration shall be brought to an end by moving from administration to creditors voluntary liquidation in accordance with paragraph 83 of Schedule B1 to the Insolvency Act 1986.
- 5.3 In the event that there is no dividend available to ordinary creditors, the administration shall be brought to an end by moving from administration to dissolution in accordance with paragraph 84 of Schedule B1 to the Insolvency Act 1986.
