Respective responsibilities of directors and auditors





**Notes to the Abbreviated Accounts
for the Year Ended 31 March 2011**

1. ACCOUNTING POLICIES

Basis of preparing the financial statements

The financial statements have been prepared on the basis that the company will continue to trade for the foreseeable future. At 31 March 2011 the company's liabilities exceeded its assets by £47,293. The company is dependant upon the continued support of its creditors and directors of which a significant creditor is due to a fellow group company. The directors are confident that this support will be maintained for the foreseeable future. Should this support be withdrawn and the company be unable to continue trading, adjustments would have to be made to reduce the balance sheet values of assets to their recoverable amounts, and to reclassify fixed assets and long term liabilities as current assets and liabilities.

Accounting convention

The financial statements have been prepared under the historical cost convention and in accordance with the Financial Reporting Standard for Smaller Entities (effective April 2008).

Turnover

Turnover represents net invoiced sales of goods, excluding value added tax.

Tangible fixed assets

Depreciation is provided at the following annual rates in order to write off each asset over its estimated useful life.

Plant and machinery etc - 33% on cost, 25% on cost and 10% on cost

Stocks

Work in progress is valued at the lower of cost and net realisable value.

Cost includes all direct expenditure and an appropriate proportion of fixed and variable overheads.

Deferred tax

Deferred tax is recognised in respect of all timing differences that have originated but not reversed at the balance sheet date.
