The Lord Ordinary, having heard counsel on the opposed motion of the Petitioners, the Petition and proceedings, caveats having been honoured,

1. Appoints the Petition to be intimated on the Walls of court in common form;
2. Appoints the Petition to be advertised once in the Edinburgh Gazette and once in the Scotsman newspaper;
3. Makes an administration order in terms of paragraph 13(1)(a) to Schedule B1 of the Insolvency Act 1986 in relation to **Coffee Republic plc**, having their registered office at 50 Lothian Road, Festival Square, Edinburgh;
4. Nominates and Appoints Richard John Hill and David John Crawshaw of KPMG LLP, 100 Temple Street, Bristol, BS1 6AG, insolvency practitioners duly qualified under the Insolvency Act 1986, to be the joint administrators of the said company, acting jointly and with any either of them, in terms of paragraph 100(2) to Schedule B1 of the Insolvency Act 1986;
5. Authorises the said joint administrators to exercise the powers contained in the Insolvency Act 1986;
6. Appoints the Clerk of Court to intimate the making of this order forthwith to the joint administrators;
7. Appoints the joint administrators to advertise and give notice of this order forthwith in terms of Rule 2.19 of the Insolvency (Scotland) Rules 1986;
8. In consequence of the making of the administration order, dismisses the petition to wind up the company presented on 7 July 2009 by Coal Pension Properties Limited (case reference P906/09) and recalls the appointment of the provisional liquidator granted by Interlocutor dated 9 July 2009;
9. finds the petitioners entitled to expenses of and incidental to this petition and finds those expenses to be expenses in the administration and remits the account thereof, when lodged, to the Auditor of Court to tax; and decerns.
