#### 1. ACCOUNTING POLICIES

#### 1.1 Basis of Accounting

The financial statements have been prepared under the historical cost convention.

The company has taken advantage of the exemption from preparing a cash flow statement conferred by Financial Reporting Standard No. 1 on the grounds that it is entitled to the exemptions available in sections 246 to 247 of the Companies Act 1985 for small companies.

#### 1.2 Turnover

Turnover represents the amount derived from the provision of goods and services which fall within the company's ordinary activities stated net of value added tax.

#### 1.3 Tangible Fixed Assest and Depreciation
