The Sheriff having considered the foregoing note and Productions attached and being satisfied that the realisable assets of the Company are insufficient to cover the expenses of the liquidation and that it is appropriate to make the aforementioned Order

1. Dispenses with intimation, service and advertisement of said Note;
2. Dispenses with a Remit to an independent Accountant on the Liquidator's intromissions;
3. Approves the Liquidator's whole actings and intromissions;
4. Exonerates, Acquits and Discharges Paul Dounis and Mark Wilson, RSM UK Restructuring Advisory LLP Third Floor, 2 Sempie Street Edinburgh EH3 8BL of their whole actings, intromissions and management as Liquidator of Crystal Canopies Limited, a company incorporated under the Companies Acts (company number SC161199) and having its Registered Office at First Floor, Quay 2, 139 Fountainbridge, Edinburgh, EH3 9QG;
5. Authorises the Liquidator to retain the balance of funds in his hands in the sum of Seven Thousand and Six Pounds and Twenty Three pence (£7,006.23) Sterling to account of his remuneration;
6. Orders that the said Crystal Canopies Limited, a company incorporated under the Companies Acts (company number SC161199) and having its Registered Office at First Floor, Quay 2, 139 Fountainbridge, Edinburgh, EH3 9QG be dissolved in terms of section 204(2) of the Insolvency Act 1986;
7. Ordains the Liquidator to intimate this order to the Registrar of Companies within 14 days from this date in terms of section 204(4) of the Insolvency Act 1986, and to all creditors who have lodged claims; and
8. Dispenses with the need to convene a final meeting of creditors.
