1. STATUTORY INFORMATION

Ecosse Doors Ltd. is a private company, limited by shares, registered in Scotland. The company's registered number and registered office address can be found on the Company Information page.

2. ACCOUNTING POLICIES

Basis of preparing the financial statements

These financial statements have been prepared in accordance with the provisions of Section 1A "Small Entities" of Financial Reporting Standard 102 "The Financial Reporting Standard applicable in the UK and Republic of Ireland" and the Companies Act 2006. The financial statements have been prepared under the historical cost convention.

Turnover

Turnover represents net invoiced sales of goods, excluding value added tax and adjusted for work in progress.

Tangible fixed assets

Depreciation is provided at the following annual rates in order to write off each asset over its estimated useful life or, if held under a finance lease, over the lease term, whichever is the shorter.

Plant and machinery - 15% on reducing balance Fittings and equipment - 25% on reducing balance Motor vehicles - 25% on reducing balance

Stock and work in progress

Stock and work in progress are valued at the lower of cost and net realisable value, after making due allowance for obsolete and slow moving items. Cost includes attributable overheads where appropriate.

Financial instruments

Basic financial instruments, including debtors and creditors with no stated interest rate and receivable or payable within one year, are recorded at transaction price. Any losses arising from impairment are recognised in the profit and loss account in administrative expenses.

Taxation

Taxation for the year comprises current and deferred tax. Tax is recognised in the Income Statement, except to the extent that it relates to items recognised in other comprehensive income or directly in equity.

Current or deferred taxation assets and liabilities are not discounted.

Current tax is recognised at the amount of tax payable using the tax rates and laws that have been enacted or substantively enacted by the balance sheet date.

2. ACCOUNTING POLICIES - continued

Deferred tax

Deferred tax is recognised in respect of all timing differences that have originated but not reversed at the balance sheet date.

Timing differences arise from the inclusion of income and expenses in tax assessments in periods different from those in which they are recognised in financial statements. Deferred tax is measured using tax rates and laws that have been enacted or substantively enacted by the year end and that are expected to apply to the reversal of the timing difference.

Unrelieved tax losses and other deferred tax assets are recognised only to the extent that it is probable that they will be recovered against the reversal of deferred tax liabilities or other future taxable profits.

Hire purchase and leasing commitments

Assets obtained under hire purchase contracts or finance leases are capitalised in the balance sheet. Those held under hire purchase contracts are depreciated over their estimated useful lives. Those held under finance leases are depreciated over their estimated useful lives or the lease term, whichever is the shorter.

The interest element of these obligations is charged to profit or loss over the relevant period. The capital element of the future payments is treated as a liability.

Pension costs and other post-retirement benefits

The company operates a defined contribution pension scheme. Contributions payable to the company's pension scheme are charged to profit or loss in the period to which they relate.

10. RELATED PARTY DISCLOSURES

The director A McIntyre owns 100% of a related company, A McIntyre Joinery Limited, with whom the company trades on normal commercial terms. The company had sales to A McIntyre Joinery Ltd of £18,978 (2017 £7,131) and purchases of £241,379 (2017 £246,047). The amount due to A McIntyre Joinery Ltd at the year end amounted to £41,346 (2017 £18,842).

The director A McIntyre owns 99% of a related company, AMI Contracts Ltd, with whom the company trades on normal commercial terms. The company had sales to AMI Contracts Ltd during the year of £160 (2017 £917) and purchases from AMI Contracts Ltd of £5,250 (2017 £5,000). The amount due to AMI Contracts Ltd at the year end amounted to £11,938 (2017 £8,247).

The company occupies premises owned by A McIntyre Joinery Ltd Self Administered Pension Scheme. Rent and charges of £40,296 (2017 £40,266) was charged for the year. Insurance and maintenance paid by Ecosse Doors Ltd and charged to A McIntyre Joinery Ltd Self Administered Pension Scheme amounted to £7,306 (2017 £8,186). The amount owed by A McIntyre Joinery Limited Self Administered Pension Scheme at the year end amounted to £1,668 (2017 - owed to A McIntyre Joinery Limited Self Administered Pension Scheme £1,314).
