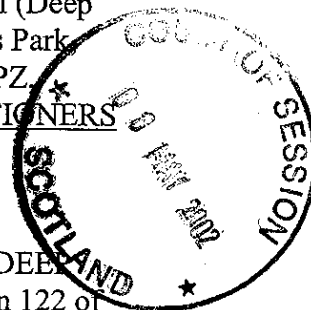

- (1) appoints the petition to be intimated on the Walls of Court in common form and appoints the petition to be advertised once in the Edinburgh Gazette and The Scotsman newspapers;
- (2) grants warrant for service of the petition as craved together with a copy of this Interlocutor upon the party named and designed in the Schedule annexed thereto, appoints them and any other party claiming an interest to lodge answers thereto within eight days after such intimation, advertisement and service;
- (3) meantime, on cause shown, until the prayer of the petition for a winding up order has been granted or refused, nominates and appoints Bryan Alan Jackson, Chartered Accountant, 78 Carlton Place, Glasgow an Insolvency Practitioner, duly qualified under the Act to be provisional liquidator of The Scottish Coal (Deep Mine) Company Limited;
- (4) authorises the provisional liquidator to exercise the powers contained in Part II of Schedule 4 of the Insolvency Act 1986, without further intervention by the Court;
- (5) appoints the petitioners to send a certified copy of this Interlocutor forthwith to the provisional liquidator; and
- (6) appoints the provisional liquidator to give notice of his appointment forthwith in terms of Rule 4.2 of the Insolvency (Scotland) Rules 1986.
