Aquados (UK) Limited - In Liquidation

Liquidator's Annual Report pursuant to Section 106 (1) of the Insolvency Act 1986 for the period from 1 March 2007 (date of liquidation) to 30 November 2009.

1. Introduction

I was appointed Liquidator of Aquados (UK) Limited ("the Company") on 1 March 2007 following the Administration of the company and present my report to the creditors and members on the progress of the liquidation.

2. Receipts and Payments Account

I attach for your information a copy of my summarised receipts and payments account for the period 1 March 2007 to date.

3. Assets

3.1 Surplus from Administrator

This represents the surplus funds forwarded to the Liquidator following the Administration of the company. The Administrators remuneration was also repaid to the Liquidation this is detailed in paragraph 5.

3.2 Book Debts

Book debts of £27,794 were outstanding upon my appointment. Many of these debts are unrecoverable. An amount of £6,367 has been realised in respect of these book debts. No further realisations will be made.

3.3 Bank Interest

Gross Bank interest totalling £2,422 has been received during the course of the liquidation. Bank Interest Net of Tax of £213 has also been received.

3.3 Other Receipts

My receipts and payments account also details various receipts. An Amount of £100 has been received in respect of a Corporation Tax refund. An amount of £20 has been received in respect of a registration fee refund.

4. Other Matters

4.1 Directors and Officers of the Company

No assets sold in the Liquidation have been purchased by any of the directors or officers of the company.

4.2 EC Regulations

The E.C Regulations on Insolvency Proceedings 2000 applies to this case, and these proceedings are main proceedings as the debtor's centre of main interest is within the European Union.

4.3 Bordereau

The case was bonded for the sum of £100,000 on 31 March 2007. I am required by statute to have in place security for the proper performance of my function. This security takes the form of a bond at least equal to the value of the Company's assets.

5. Liquidators Remuneration and Outlays

The Liquidation Committee is responsible for approving my remuneration for acting as Liquidator of the Company. It was resolved at a meeting of creditors on 12 February 2008 that the Liquidators remuneration is to be calculated by reference to the time properly spent by the Liquidator and his staff in carrying out the functions, dealing with all matters arising during the course of the Liquidation and is to be based on his normal time costs chargeable in insolvency matters, to be drawn as and when incurred and that the Liquidator is authorised to reclaim Outlays including those Outlays classed as Category 2, properly charged or incurred in carrying out his duties in the course of the Liquidation, these Outlays to be paid as an expense of the Liquidation.

Total time charged since the date of my appointment has amounted to £53,704.30. Outlays have amounted to £1,515.26. This includes Outlays incurred internally (SIP 9 category 2) as detailed on the attached printouts. Upon closure of my administration I will have written off over £41,000 in respect of my time costs.

The Liquidation Committee has authorises the payment of my fees from the funds in hand. Office holder's fees have been drawn in accordance with the attached receipts and payments account amounting to £12,597.

We are obliged to provide creditors with a split of time between different charge classifications and between each type of staff member dealing with the case. These can be seen in the attached Chargeout Summary.

The Creditors Guide to Liquidator's fees and supplement guide detailing our chargeout rates and disbursements policy can be found on our website www.gibsonboothinsol.com, news and information section.

Explanatory notes to the attached summary of time costs

Administration and Planning

Work performed includes case planning, administrative set up, notification of the appointment as required by the relevant legislation, maintenance of our working files and insolvency case record, compliance, cashiering, accounting and statutory reporting.

Realisation of Assets

Work performed includes identifying, securing and insuring the assets, dealing with any sale of the business, dealing with any retention of title claims over the assets, transition of contracts, property issues, collecting the debts and disposal of the stock and other assets. Our disposal strategy is described more fully in the attached report.

Creditors

Work performed includes setting up of our creditor records for secured, preferential and non-preferential creditors and for the employees, communication with the creditors/employees after our appointment by telephone and by letter, as required, dealing with creditors/employee correspondence and telephone calls and, where appropriate, agreeing creditors/employees claims in the insolvency proceedings and distribution of funds. Work also includes providing reports to Banks/secured creditors as necessary.

Investigations

Work performed includes review of the directors' conduct in accordance with the Statement of Insolvency Practice number 2 and submission of a report on the directors' conduct to the Department of Trade and Industry (the content of which is confidential). Also investigating any apparent antecedent transactions and the company's affairs.

As mentioned previously a large amount of investigation work had been conducted by me as Administrator.

Liquidator's Overview of the Case and Duties

- Protecting and realising the assets.
- · Setting up the case including entering all creditors and amounts due.
- Opening bank accounts and entering case onto our cashiering system.
- Advising creditors of our appointment and advising them to prove in the liquidation.
- Submitting VAT returns to HM customs & Excise and P35's and P14's up to the date of appointment to the Inland Revenue.
- · Liasing with fixed charge holders.
- Dealing with preferential and ordinary/unsecured creditors claims including employees.
- Completing and submitting report on the Director's to the Department of Trade & Industry (D.Forms).
- Reconciling the local bank account on a monthly basis, and the account held at the Bank of England, Insolvency Services Account on a quarterly basis.
- Agreeing the claims of the preferential creditors i.e. VAT, PAYE, and NI, Department of Employment, and Employees.
- Acknowledging all ordinary/unsecured claims and agreeing when a dividend is payable. This includes tracing any creditors which are material that have not claimed.
- Reviewing the file initially and carrying out full reviews on a six monthly basis (minimum).

- Complying with Statutory matters including the filing of statutory receipts and payments account on a six monthly basis and ensuring compliance with Regulation 17, the Insolvency Practitioners Record.
- Insuring the case, required by statute, for the maximum monies held and ensuring this is adequate at all times. (Bordereau).
- Keeping a record of all time and disbursements spent. The time spent between types of job and type of work to comply with Statement of Insolvency Practice 9 (from 31 December 2002).
- Preparing annual reports to distribute to all creditors, directors and shareholders.

6.1 Solicitors Costs

Dundas & Wilson Solicitors Glasgow were instructed as regards to the process of the application to court seeking approval of the Administrators remuneration and outlays.

They were instructed on the basis that their fees would be based on their normal charge out rate as shown on the receipts and payments account.

6.2 Agents Costs

No agents have been instructed.

6.3 Forensic Accountant

A Forensic Accountant of Grant Thornton Chartered Accountants was appointed by the Administrator to review his investigations into the affairs of the Company. A creditor of the company deposited an amount of £11,500 with the Administrator to pay the costs of the Forensic Accountant. This deposit was forwarded to the Liquidator upon the ending of the Administration.

These funds have been utilised by the Liquidator and the costs of the Forensic Accountant have been paid through the Liquidation.

They were instructed on the basis that their fees would be based on their normal charge out rate as shown on the receipts and payments account. The Forensic Account was subject to a confidentiality agreement to report only to the Administrator.

6.4 Court Reporter

A Court Reporter of Hastings & Co Chartered Accountants was appointed by the court in respect of the approval of the Administrator's remuneration and outlays. In accordance with interlocutor of the court his fee has been paid by the Liquidator as can be seen on the attached receipts and payments account.
