INTRODUCTION

Baker Energy Limited (Entity) entered members' voluntary liquidation on 11 January 2022. Emma Cray and Steven Sherry were appointed joint liquidators of the Entity (Liquidators).

This is the Liquidators' final account of the liquidation and covers the period from 11 January 2022 to 31 October 2023. For the purposes of the summary receipts and payments account (at Appendix A), the Liquidators also set out what has been received and paid in the period since their last progress report, being from 11 January 2022 to 31 October 2023 (the Period). You may also refer to the Liquidators' previous progress report for the period from 11 January 2022 to 10 January 2023.

Statutory information relating to the Entity and the Liquidators is at Appendix B.

REPORT ON THE LIQUIDATION

Realisation of assets:

There were no assets identified within the Director's Declaration of Solvency.

The Liquidators have not identified any additional assets of the Entity and are not aware of any other assets that remain to be realised.

Settlement of liabilities:

The Director's Declaration of Solvency showed that the Entity had no liabilities.

As previously reported, the Liquidators published a notice in the Edinburgh Gazette inviting creditors to submit details of claims they may have against the Entity.

The Liquidators have not received any claims in the liquidation.

HM Revenue & Customs ("HMRC"):

As previously reported, the Liquidators wrote to HMRC to inform them of the liquidation and to request details of any outstanding liabilities.

HMRC issued Late Filing Penalty notices in the total sum of £200, for the late submission of the Entity's pre-liquidation tax returns. The penalties were settled together with interest, by the Entity's ultimate beneficial owner on a non-recourse basis, as applicable.

Following submission of the Entity's final pre-liquidation tax returns and settlement of the above penalties plus interest, on 31 August 2023, HMRC confirmed that the Entity has no outstanding tax liabilities and that they have no objection to the liquidation being closed.

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Distributions to Members:

As no assets were realised during the course of the liquidation, no distribution was made to the Member of the Entity.

LIQUIDATORS' FEES AND EXPENSES

Basis of remuneration

The basis of the Liquidators' remuneration has been fixed by reference to the time properly given by them and their staff in dealing with the liquidation, in accordance with a resolution dated 11 January 2022.

Liquidators' remuneration and expenses

Fees and expenses of the liquidation have been paid to PricewaterhouseCoopers LLP by another group company under a separate contractual arrangement. There is no recourse to the liquidation estate.

The Liquidators have separately provided the member with the information required in accordance with Statement of Insolvency Practice 7 Scotland.

Members are entitled to request further information about the Liquidators' fees and expenses. Such requests should be addressed to the Liquidators via the email address stated in this account and need to be made within 21 days of receipt of this report.
