The Sheriff, having resumed consideration of the foregoing petition together with the productions produced, and having seen the Edinburgh Gazette dated 30 January 2015 and the Press and Journal newspaper dated 29 January 2015 each containing the intimation ordered by the preceding interlocutor, no answers to said petition having been lodged in court, Finds (1) that the amount of the share capital of the said Gordons Travel (Scotland) Limited paid up or credited as paid up does not exceed £120,000 (2) that the said company is unable to pay its debts; therefore Orders that the said company having its registered office at 269 Holburn Street, Aberdeen AB10 7FL be wound up in pursuance of the Insolvency Act, 1986; Nominates and Appoints David Kelso Hunter, 10 Carden Place, Aberdeen AB10 1UR to be the interim liquidator of the said company with the usual powers, all in terms of said Statute and of Law; Finds the petitioner entitled to the expenses of this application and Directs same to be expenses in the liquidation.
