

the Bank means The Royal Bank of Scotland plc, a company incorporated under the Companies Acts with registered number 90312 and having its registered office at 36 St Andrew Square, Edinburgh, EH2 2YB;

the Charge means the bond and floating charge by the Chargor in favour of the Bank dated 29 March 2001;

the Chargor means Wallace Property Investments Limited, a company incorporated under the Companies Acts with registered number 216019 and having its registered office at Phoenix House, Phoenix Crescent, Strathclyde Business Park, Bellshill, ML4 3NJ;

Encumbrance means any mortgage, pledge, lien, charge, assignment by way of security, assignation in security, hypothec, security interest, title retention, preferential right or trust arrangement or any other security agreement or arrangement having the effect of security;

Loan Agreement means the loan agreement between the Chargor and the Bank dated of even date with the execution of the Charge;

Permitted Encumbrance has the meaning given to it in the Loan Agreement;

Secured Assets means the whole of the property (including uncalled capital) which is or may be from time to time while the Charge is in force comprised in the property and undertaking of the Chargor; and

Secured Liabilities means all present and future obligations and liabilities of the Chargor to the Bank, whether actual, contingent, sole, joint and/or several or otherwise, including, without prejudice to the foregoing generality, all obligations to indemnify the Bank.

The amount secured by the Charge is the Secured Liabilities.

Paper Apart 2

The property charged by the Charge is the Secured Assets.

Paper Apart 3

The floating charge created by the Charge shall, subject to Section 464(2) of the Companies Act 1985, rank in priority to any fixed security which shall be created by the Charger after its execution of the Charge, other than a fixed security in favour of the

Bank and to any other floating charge which shall be created by the Chargor after its execution of the Charge and, subject as aforesaid, no such fixed security or other floating charge shall rank in priority to or equally with the Charge.

Except with the prior written consent of the Bank, the Chargor shall not create, incur, assume or permit to subsist any Encumbrance on all or any part of the Secured Assets except for any Permitted Encumbrance.
