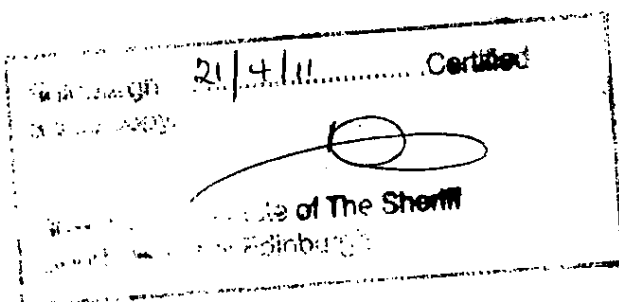

The sheriff having resumed consideration of the foregoing petition together with the productions produced, and having seen the Edinburgh Gazette dated 5 April, 2011 and the Scotsman newspaper dated 4 April, 2011 each containing the intimation ordered by the preceding interlocutor, no answers to said petition having been lodged in court, Finds (1) that the amount of the share capital of the said **RENEWABLE DEVICES SWIFT TURBINES LIMITED** paid up or credited as paid up does not exceed £120,000 (2) that the said company is unable to pay its debts (3) that the said company has by special resolution resolved that the company be wound up by the court;

therefore Orders that the said company having its registered office at S.A.C., Bush Estate, Edinburgh, EH26 0PH be wound up in pursuance of the Insolvency Act, 1986; Nominates and Appoints Blair Carnegie Nimmo and Gerard Anthony Friar, both of KPMG LLP, 191 West George Street, Glasgow, G2 2LJ to be the joint interim liquidators of the said company with the usual powers, all in terms of said Statute and of Law, authorises the joint interim liquidators to advertise their appointment in the Edinburgh Gazette and the Scotsman Newspaper in lieu of sending notices to creditors and others in terms of Rule 4.18(4) of the Insolvency (Scotland) Rules 1986, such notice to be in accordance with Rule 4.18(5) of the foregoing Rules; Finds the petitioners entitled to the expenses of this application as taxed by the auditor of court.
