The declaration of solvency, sworn by the directors prior to the commencement of the liquidation, showed a debt totalling £1 due from Gresham 4 GP Limited ('the Debt'), the Company's immediate parent. The Debt has been distributed by set off (see 'Distributions' below).

Creditors

The Company had no known creditors. A notice to creditors to prove their claims in the liquidation was advertised in the Edinburgh Gazette on 3 March 2021. No creditors were forthcoming as a result of this advertisement.

Tax

All pre-liquidation corporation tax matters were handled by Brass Tax Consultancy who prepared and submitted all outstanding returns up to the date of the commencement of the liquidation to HM Revenue & Customs ('HMRC'). At the request of the Joint Liquidators, HMRC subsequently confirmed that the Company had no outstanding corporation tax returns or liabilities, that it would not raise enquiries into any pre or post liquidation periods and that it had no objection to the Joint Liquidators taking steps to bring the liquidation to a conclusion.

A similar assurance was sought and received from HMRC in respect of PAYE and VAT matters.

Distributions

On 10 September 2021 the Joint Liquidators declared a first and final distribution of the assets of the Company to Gresham 4 GP Limited, as the sole beneficial shareholder of the Company.

The distribution was at the rate of £1 per £1 share and was effected by set off against the debt of £1 due to the Company by Gresham 4 GP Limited.
