#### Accounting convention

Stocks are valued at the lower of cost and net realisable value, after making due allowance for obsolete and slow moving items

#### Deferred tax

Deferred tax is recognised in respect of all timing differences that have originated but not reversed at the balance sheet date

#### **Deferred Grants**

Capital grants received have been included in long term creditors and are being released to the profit and loss account over the expected useful life of the assets to which they relate

#### **Restricted Funds**

The accounts include a £5,000 00 balance held in the company bank account. Which is held for the purpose of capital expenditure on refurbishment/fitting out of the museum
