Fixtures and Equipment 15% reducing balance

#### Deferred taxation -

Provision is made at current rates for taxation deferred in respect of all material timing differences except to the extent that, in the opinion of the directors, there is reasonable probability that the liability will not arise in the foreseeable future.

#### Turnover -

Turnover represents the amount receivable for services provided, excluding value added tax.
